Over 40 years, Sunil Gupta's socially engaged practice has interwoven the themes of sexuality, race and (self)identity. This resource is an exhibition pack for Gupta's show [From Here to Eternity: Sunil Gupta. A retrospective](#) and is available as a downloadable resource for schools unable to make visits to The Photographers' Gallery to see the exhibition.

The Exhibition Pack includes:

- a short biography of the artist
- audio descriptions of three photographs to listen to, either individually or as a class
- an exclusive video interview with the artist
- a selection of images with accompanying discussion points and activities for use in the classroom
- two photography assignments

By engaging with the information, discussion points and activities contained within this resource, pupils will be able to:

- list three key themes or issues Sunil Gupta's work has addressed;
- identify, through visual clues, the difference between documentary and staged photography;
- produce either documentary or staged photography images directly related to a theme or issue.
